April 2007 Availability Statistics:

- ✓ Core Routers: 100% Uptime
- ✓ Distribution Routers: 99.98% Uptime
- ✓ Managed Site Total: 99.63% Uptime

A discussion regarding infrastructure consolidation began in August 2006, and Kan-ed utilized Calence to conduct a study to review opportunities for efficiency between the 3 state networks (Kan-ed, KanWIN, and KanREN). Currently, Higher Ed is in the process of organizing its networking requirements. Kan-ed is reviewing Calence recommendations and looking at contract negotiations.
